Title	Extracurricular Participation by Charter/Cyber Charter Students

### **Authority**

The Board shall approve participation in the district's extracurricular activities and interscholastic athletic programs by a student enrolled in a charter or cyber charter school if all of the following conditions are met:

1. The Student is a resident of the school district.
2. The charter or cyber charter school does not provide the same extracurricular activity or interscholastic athletic program.
3. The student fulfills all requirements for participation in the activity or program required by district students.

The Board shall not provide individual transportation for students enrolled in charter or cyber charter schools who participate in the district's extracurricular activities or interscholastic athletic programs. When the district provides transportation to and from and away competition, game, event, or exhibition and requires district students to use district transportation, charter/cyber charter students shall be required to use the transportation provided by the district.

The Board will require the charter or cyber charter school to pay the cost of the expenses for its students' participation in the district's extracurricular activities or interscholastic athletic programs. If the charter or cyber charter school will not pay then the student will be required to pay, with payments to be made prior to the first formal game or contest of that particular activity.

Established extracurricular activities and interscholastic athletic program fees/costs will be based on total participants, number of contests, transportation, entry fees, supervision and maintenance costs and will be reviewed and update routinely as needed.

### **Guidelines**

Charter and cyber charter school students shall be given an equal opportunity to compete for positions and participate in extracurricular activities and interscholastic athletic programs.

The following guidelines shall govern participation in the district's extracurricular activities and interscholastic athletic programs by eligible charter and cyber charter school students, who shall:

1. Meet the same eligibility criteria required of district students.
2. Maintain appropriate insurance coverage, consistent with the cover requirements for district students.
3. Comply with Board policies and school rules and regulations regarding extracurricular activities and interscholastic athletics.

4. Comply with policies and school rules and regulations regarding extracurricular activities and interscholastic.
5. Meet the requirements for physical examinations and physical fitness.
6. Comply with all requirements and directives of the district staff, coaches, and administrators involved with the extracurricular activity or interscholastic athletic program.
7. Meet attendance and reporting requirements established for all participants of the activity or program.

If a class for credit held during the school day by the school district is required for participation in an activity that takes place outside of the class, charter/cyber charter students may petition the Superintendent to audit the class in order to meet the eligibility requirement for participation in the activity that takes place outside of the class. Such petitions shall be granted subject to the student meeting any other prerequisites and there is space in the class after students enrolled in the school district have had the first opportunity to enroll in the the for-credit class. Continued participation in the activity outside of the class shall be dependent on regular attendance at and participation in the for-credit class. The student shall be responsible for all transportation and costs associated with his/her auditing the for-credit class and participating in the related out-of-class activities. Class sessions would be calculated at \$10.00 per session.

Students attending home education programs shall be given an equal opportunity to compete for positions and participate in district extracurricular activities and interscholastic athletic programs.

A home education student may participate in extracurricular activities and interscholastic athletic programs only at the school building the student would be assigned to if he/she was enrolled in the school district at no cost.

Home education students will not be charged the established cost of expenses for their participation in the district's extracurricular or interscholastic athletic programs.

Prior to trying-out or joining an activity, a home education student shall submit required documents and written verification of eligibility to the building principal by March 30 preceding the school year in which they want to participate.

To be considered in attendance in accordance with Board policy, the home education student must participate in a full, normally scheduled academic program, in accordance with the planned education program and submitted and required documentation.

## **Delegation of Responsibility**

The building principal shall be responsible to obtain from the charter or cyber charter school written confirmation that a student has met and continues to meet the established participation requirements for extracurricular activity or interscholastic athletic program participation. The confirmation shall include the student's attendance record and grades, where applicable.
