Dear CGSD Family,

After an assessment of the following variables which include a “Substantial” community level designation, the presence of confirmed COVID cases in our schools, a high number of students quarantining and many “presumed” cases that are still pending, the Central Greene School District will be moving to the remote learning model beginning on Monday, November 16th and continuing through the Thanksgiving holiday. The goal is to return to the hybrid instructional model on December 1st, but that will be determined by assessing the variables mentioned above. We will be sure to provide you with that recommendation in a timely manner.

We have been working closely with the Department of Health, and they have strongly endorsed our proactive approach to deter the spread of the virus in our schools. Please know that all of the confirmed cases involving our children and staff were a result of community transmission and were not school related. With that said, I urge you to take necessary precautions to limit the spread of COVID-19 in our school community.

- Wear a mask and maintain a physical distance of at least 6 feet from any person while outside the home and avoid sharing food, drinks, or utensils.
- Stay home when you are sick. Watch for symptoms of COVID-19 including cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fever, chills, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, and/or diarrhea.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water are not available, use alcohol-based hand sanitizers that contain at least 60% alcohol.
- Cover your coughs and sneezes with a tissue and then dispose of the tissue and clean your hands immediately. If you do not have a tissue, please use your sleeve.
- Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces.
- If you are contacted by the Pennsylvania Department of Health or your local health department please cooperate with monitoring and follow all instructions so that other people do not become sick.
