CENTRAL GREENE SCHOOL DISTRICT
SCHOOL BOARD VACANCY

The Board of School Directors of Central Greene School District (hereafter “Board”) is seeking application to fill a vacancy on the Board due to resignation dated January 27, 2023. In accordance with the School Laws of Pennsylvania, the members of the Board intend to fill the vacancy at a public meeting held on February 21, 2023. The individual appointed shall serve until December 4, 2023. The Pennsylvania Public School Code of 1949 24 P.S. § 3-322 defines eligible candidates as "Any citizen of this Commonwealth, having a good moral character, being eighteen (18) years of age or upwards, and having been a resident of the district for at least one (1) year, prior to the date of his election or appointment." A successful applicant shall be a resident of Whiteley, Wayne, or Perry Township. There are further limitations relating to those who hold other government offices or positions in the School District. School Board Directors serve voluntarily and without pay.

Eligible individuals interested in being considered for this vacant position should provide a letter of interest and complete an application which may be found on the District’s website, <https://www.cgsd.org>, or at the Administration Office located at 250 S. All eligible candidates must be present and will be interviewed at the public meeting to be held on Tuesday, February 21, 2023 beginning at 6:00 p.m. The Board is expected to act on the appointment of a successful candidate during the public meeting. Once approved by the Board, the successful candidate will be required to file a statement of financial interests and take an oath of office before entering upon his/her duties.
