DO I QUALIFY FOR AID?

Through a program by the Department of Education, high school students taking college credits at CCBC can potentially access free money through the Federal Pell Grant Program.

Students enrolled in a High School Academy or in dual enrollment courses can now apply for the Federal Pell Grant.
